The New Brunswick Public Library Service

This year (2016) marked the second phase of a pilot project in partnership with the Kings Landing Historical Settlement. During the month of September, patrons at all New Brunswick public libraries could check out free passes to Kings Landing. In total, **2,910** passes were checked out at **54** NBPLS service points. Of those passes, **804** were checked out to new cards. Also, **1,694** passes were redeemed at the attraction. This was an expansion of a pilot that saw passes checked out exclusively at York Region libraries.

The Oromocto Public Library has changed its name and is now the Fay Tidd Public Library.
