NBPLS partnered with the *Village historique acadien* – a living museum portraying the daily lives of the Acadians from 1770 to 1949 – to offer free passes to the site during the *Semaine provinciale de la fierté française* (March 19-25). More than 4,000 people checked out a pass during the week-long promotion, and over 800 people signed up for a library card in order to get a pass. The passes are redeemable at the *Village* for one visit on any day between June 11 and September 30, 2017. The promotion was an expansion of a partnership between NBPLS and the Kings Landing Historical Settlement that began two years ago.
